

Dawn McCormick Memorial Softball Umpires Unlimited Scholarship Program

Every year, Softball Umpires Unlimited will award college scholarships to graduating female seniors who desire to play softball at the college level, who demonstrate high academic standards and demonstrate commitment to and involvement in community service. Softball Umpires Unlimited will award 2 scholarships each year, \$1000 and \$500 anticipated (subject to change based on donations received), for the upcoming college year (typically fall to spring).

The application process begins Jan. 1 of the current year and ends May 30th of the current year. Applications are due May 30th of the current year. Applicants will be notified by July 15th of the current year.

Who is Eligible?

The program is available to current graduating High School Female Seniors who have been granted the opportunity to play college softball and are actively rostered on a registered ASA Metro Atlanta* Fast Pitch Softball team.

How many scholarships are available?

Softball Umpires Unlimited will award 2 scholarships each year to the winning candidates. The scholarships are in the amounts of \$1000 and \$500, with \$1000 being awarded to the 1st place candidate and \$500 to the second place candidate. These amounts may fluctuate in any given year**; 100% of donations will be applied.

When are applications due?

Applications are accepted from Jan. 1st of the current year through May 30th of the current year.

Applications will not be accepted after May 30th of the current year.

What information is required?

Winners will be selected primarily on academic merit and your involvement in your respective community and with your softball organization. ACT and/or SAT scores are required. Candidates will be required to complete an application and finalists may be asked to an in-person interview before the selection board.

How do I get an application?

SUU will not provide applications prior to Jan. 1st of the current year.

Selection of recipients will be based on solid academic performance, exemplary community service and your love for the game. Consideration may also be given to participation and leadership in school activities. Financial need is not considered, and no financial statements will be requested. Awards are for undergraduate study only and are granted without regard to race, color, creed, religion or national origin.

*** A Player rostered in the current year with an ASA Georgia State Fast Pitch Softball team may apply on the basis of prior participation on a registered ASA Metro Atlanta Fast Pitch Softball team.**

**** All proceeds are placed in a scholarship fund account, award amounts determined by the committee, with any remaining funds carried over into the following year's award.**
